



## REGULAR MEETING

Town of Richibucto  
March 19<sup>th</sup>, 2019

The regular meeting held on March 19<sup>th</sup> was called to order at 7:00 p.m.

### **19-29**

It was moved by councilor Mazerolle that the agenda be adopted with the following additions:

Article 8(i) – Minor Hockey

Article 8(ii) – Echo at the Arena, CMA Concert

This was seconded by councilor G. Richard. Motion carried.

### **19-30**

It was moved by councilor Thompson that the minutes of the regular meeting held on February 19<sup>th</sup> be adopted as presented. This was seconded by councilor S. Richard. Motion carried.

## **BUSINESS ARISING FROM MINUTES**

The general manager informed council that the peddler's by-law already has a section concerning festivals and special events. She also informed the council that the public notice concerning the rezoning was posted on the Commission's site.

## **CORRESPONDANCES**

Letter from Mr. Edgar LeBlanc, EL Expert Event Management, asking the municipality to host a concert from 1755 and Reveil at the Atlas Gazebo July 27<sup>th</sup>, 2019.

The manager informed council that sound tests were made at the Imperial Kent North Center, and the sound is not good for the concert.

**19-31**

It was moved by councilor Mazerolle that the general manager tries to find solutions to the sound problems, and that she takes the necessary measure to organize the concert with EL Expert Event Management, favoring the center for the event. This was seconded by councilor G. Richard. Motion carried.

Letter from Mrs. Stella Richard, Scallop Festival, asking to reserve the Gazebo and Anchor during the scallop festival, which will be held July 17<sup>th</sup> to the 21<sup>st</sup>. The General manager is going to contact the festival to verify if there is a reason, they want the anchor. If not, we will reserve the Imperial Kent North Center instead.

**19-32**

It was moved by councilor Mazerolle that the Town of Richibucto authorizes the Scallop Festival to use our installations, from July 17<sup>th</sup> to 21<sup>st</sup>, which will be defined by the general manager. This was seconded by councilor Thompson. Motion carried.

Letter from Mr. Ian Mackillop, Mackillop Promotions, informing council that they would like to organize a boxing event at the Imperial Kent North Center, either July 13<sup>th</sup> or 19<sup>th</sup>.

**19-33**

It was moved by councilor Thompson that we accept in principle to rent the arena for a boxing event, but the manager has to get in contact with the promoters to work out the details. This was seconded by councilor S. Richard. Motion carried.
